Is Children's Pool the only place seals live in Southern California?

Watch out for the fine print.

Children's Pool is the only *recognized mainland* seal rookery in So. California. Lots of claims have been printed leaving out the qualifiers.

Wild seals rarely congregate on mainland. They find rocks just offshore or tiny pocket beaches with their backs to a cliff. This is instinctive. CP is one of the rare places where seals are comfortable enough to lie out on sand in front of people they know can easily outrun them.

There is no scientific definition of a seal rookery – Colloquially, it is "a place where adult and young seals are observed" Wild seals make it their business not to be observed.
